True Colors: Rx for Bullying Behaviors

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Schoolhouse Statistics

- 64% of bullied at school do not report the incident
- 85% of reported incidences have no effort or consequences by teachers or school administration
- 57% of bullying situations STOP when peers intervene and are not bystanders
- 22% of students report being bullied during the school year.
- 35% of students report being bullied on-line.
- 160,000 kids stay home annually for fear of bullying at school.
- Students who are bullied are 2x more likely to have health issues.
- Over 14% of high school students have considered suicide, 7% attempted.
- 50% of suicides in Britain are from bullying related incidences
- Bully victims 9x more likely to commit suicide

Workplace Statistics (2010 Workplace Survey)

- 37% of Americans have been bullied; 49% have witnessed bullying
- 45% of people targeted by a bully experience stress-related health problems including anxiety, panic attacks, and clinical depression.
- Over 71.5 million Americans are affected with bullying in the workplace

Industry Statistics (2013 Workplace Survey)

- 27% healthcare
- 23% education
- 16% public service
- 10% service industry
- 10% IT & manufacturing
- 14% other
